## PayPal payments: Setting up Non Paypal account (Buyer does not need to create a PayPal account to checkout)

To accept credit card payments in PayPal and buyer doesn't need to have a PayPal account to complete payment.

Simply enable "Non-PayPal account" checkbox in the payment settings to allow buyers to checkout without having to create a PayPal account.

- Open shop in ShopFactory
- Click **Central** dropdown button -> **Payment methods accepted**
- Select **"Show All"** from the **"Country"** dropdown menu.
- Scroll down and tick **"PayPal"** checkbox and then click Next button.
- Enter your PayPal Email address.
- Enable **"Non-PayPal Account"** checkbox

*Buyer does not need to create a PayPal account to checkout and landing page for Non-PayPal account.*

- Select the currencies you want to accept - make sure the currencies you enable here match your shop currencies.
