Setting up QuickPay as a payment option in my shop

- Open your shop in ShopFactory
- Click on Central dropdown -> Payment Methods Accepted
- The payment providers list shows up, enable the payment you want by ticking it in this case, tick "QuickPay" option



- Click Next
- Enter your QuickPay merchant account details (merchant, md5 secret/APIkey, currencies supported, etc.)

Note: You MUST enter your ID for "Agreement ID (V10)" to use the QuickPay V10 module. If you leave "Agreement ID (v10)" field empty then it will automatically use the old gateway.
