Note: **Stripe for ShopFactory** platform is limited to ShopFactory V14 onwards.

Stripe is an easy way to accept payments online. You can sign up for a Stripe merchant account without setup fees nor monthly fees.

Stripe is available to businesses in more than 40 countries. With Stripe, you can accept all major debit and credit cards from customers as well as Digital Wallet payments such as Apple Pay, Google Pay, Alipay, Microsoft Pay, WeChat Pay, etc. plus other local payment methods including Klarna, Giropay, iDeal, SEPA Direct Debit and many more.

Stripe for ShopFactory platform allows you to accept payments directly on your online shop. With Stripe, customers stay on your online shop during checkout instead of being redirected to an externally hosted checkout page, which has been proven to lead to higher conversion rates.

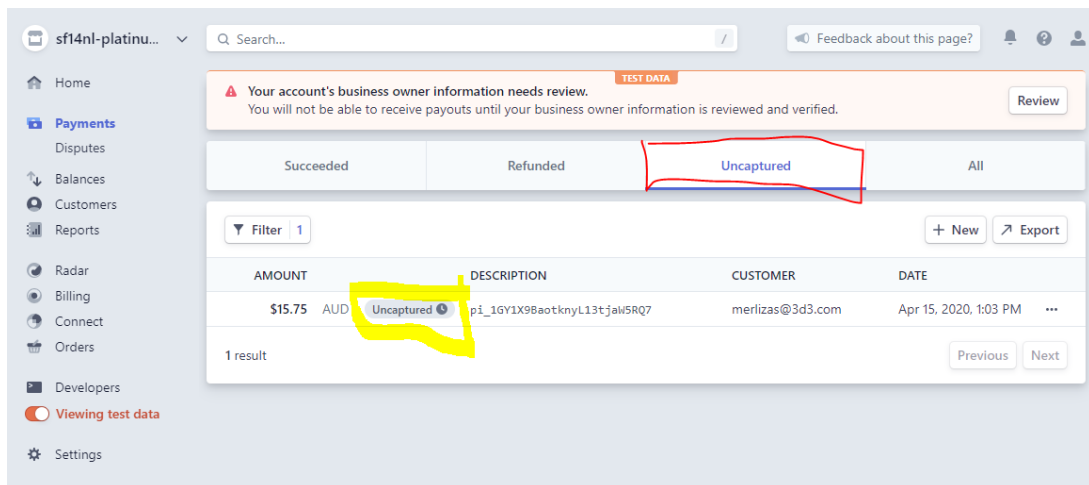

- Save and publish the shop so that the changes are uploaded online

- Now, when a buyer completes the order – the merchant will have to login to their Stripe merchant account dashboard and go into the PAYMENTS section – select the UNCAPTURED column and select a transaction – for example:

- Then on the top right, select CAPTURE
