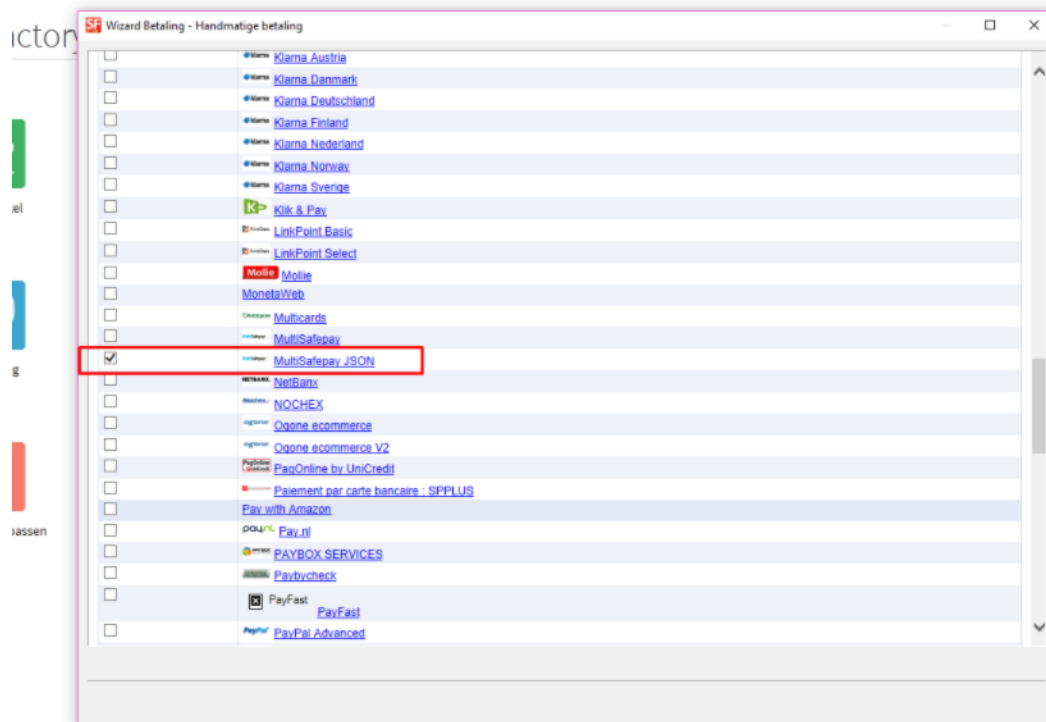
**Note:** Your API key will be required to be able to setup your shop. Login to your Multisafepay merchant account -> **Settings** -> **Website Settings**

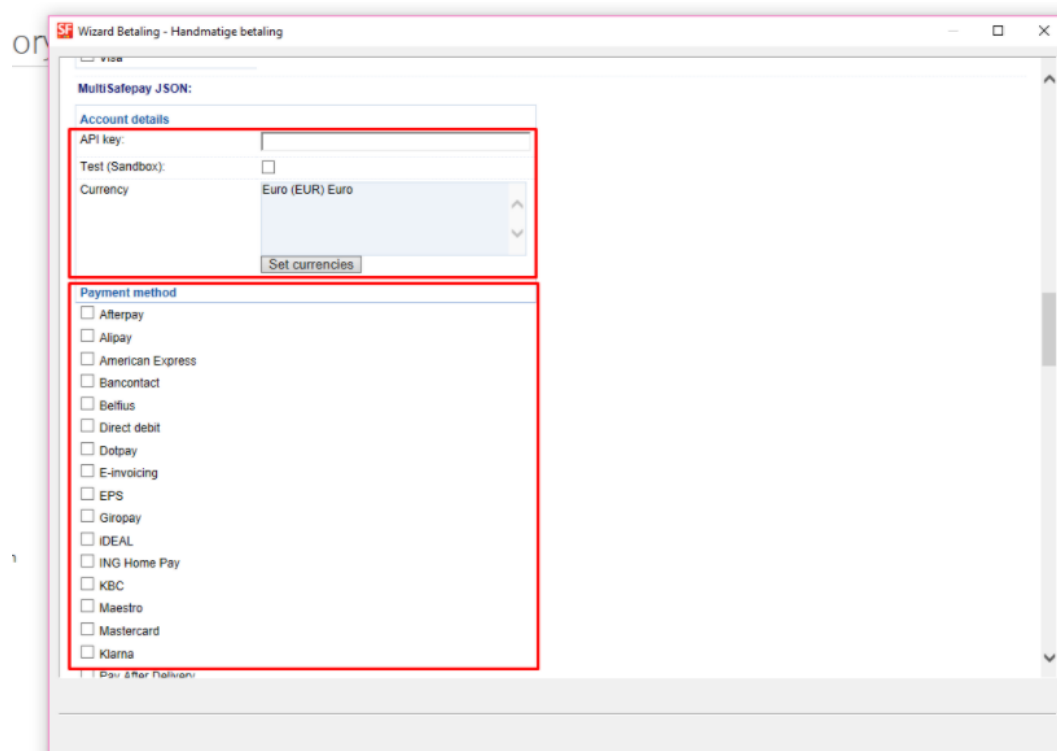

- Click -> Central drop-down menu -> Payment methods accepted
- From the Payment Providers list, tick "**MultiSafepay JSON**"



- Scroll down the page and click NEXT button
- Enter your **MultiSafepay JSON** account details
- Tick the card types under **MultiSafepay JSON** supported Payment Methods that you want to enable in your shop.



- Click Next

- Click Finish
- Save and preview your shop. Place a test order.
- Republish your shop so that the changes are uploaded online
