***This setting must be turned ON for Google eCommerce tracking code to work - the data in the Thank you page is used by Google so you need to point the Return URL to the **Thank you** page.

With Auto Return for Website Payments, your buyers are redirected back to your site immediately after clicking the Pay button on the Payment Confirmation page.

To set up Auto Return:

1. Log in to your PayPal account and click the **Profile** sub-tab under **My Account**.
2. Click the "My selling tools" -> **Website Payment Preferences** -> and click on Update.

Auto Return for Website Payments

Auto Return for Website Payments brings your buyers back to your website immediately after payment completion. Auto Return applies to PayPal Website Payments, including Buy Now, Donations, Subscriptions and Shopping Cart. [Learn More](#)

1. Auto Return: On  **Select "ON" radio option**

Return URL: Enter the URL that will be used to redirect your customers upon payment completion. This URL must meet the guidelines detailed below. [Learn More](#)

2. Return URL: **Enter your shop URL or Thank you URL here, i.e.**

Return URL Requirements: The following items are required in order to set up Auto Return:

- In accordance with the User Agreement, you must provide written information on the page displayed by the Return URL that will help the buyer understand that the payment has been made and that the transaction has been completed.
- You must provide written information on the page displayed by the Return URL that explains that payment transaction details will be emailed to the buyer.
- Example: Thank you for your payment. Your transaction has been completed and a receipt for your purchase has been emailed to you. You may log into your account at www.paypal.com/au to view details of this transaction.

3. Scroll down the page and click "Save" button

5. Click **Save** button.
