I am using a grid productloop style that shows 4 products/paragraphs per row. I want to show the last row with 4 products across.

I want to show more products on the first page on a department, where do I change this setting?

How can I define the number of products to be displayed per page?

You can change the **Split Pages** setting by going to **Settings** menu -> **Global Settings** -> **Settings for this website** -> **MISCELLANEOUS**

- Locate the “**Autosplit page if it contains more products/paragraphs than:**”
- As an example, change the value to 40 so that will show 4 products/paragraphs per row (10 rows before the page is split to Page 2, Page 3, etc.) *Note: Do not enter a very high number in this setting as it will affect page loading speed i.e. 200 products per page will take time to load. Also, do not enter a negative value here.*
